

5 FOLD MINISTRY PRAYER POINTS 2022

PRAYER is important for Colorado Christian Fellowship (CCF). In order to assure that CCF is united in unceasing and intercessory prayer, the following **5-Fold Ministry Prayer Points** have been prepared for our congregation. Prayer helps us to be aware of the spiritual forces at work in our community, world, families, work places, etc.; and it equips us for those battles. Prayer reveals the heart and mind of God, and allows our spirits to be in alignment with His. When we pray, we remove our fleshly eyes so our spiritual eyes can be opened, allowing us to be open to God's desires and direction. Prayer reveals the heart and mind of God. CCF believes in the five-fold ministry leadership gifts – apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher, and we want to pray that those with those gifts are strengthened and that those gifts are used to bring Father's love and the Gospel message to the world.

Pray that Apostles...

1. will declare His word fearlessly. Ephesians 6:19-20
2. will receive heightened revelation and remain humble. 2 Corinthians 12:7
3. will be birthed and adequately trained in this season. Acts 18:24-26
4. will move in signs and wonders. 2 Corinthians 12:12
5. will speak with the demonstration of God's power. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5
6. will operate in supernatural wisdom to build the church. 1 Corinthians 3:10
7. will understand and fully embrace their roles as spiritual fathers. 1 Corinthians 4:15

Pray that Prophets...

1. watch and pray! That is the position and posture of prophets. Luke 21:36
2. fast and pray. Mark 9:29
3. pursue Father's Heart. Psalm 103:13
4. desire to see and hear well! Have Father translate what is seen with the natural eye and heard with the natural ear. Hear and see as Father does! Isaiah 30:19-22
5. are confident in each one's unique call as His prophet. 1 Peter 2:9-10
6. are present and available to Him to receive His assignments (to pray, intercede, release the word of the Lord...) Ephesians 4:11

7. communicate the Father's Heart. Keep their heart pure by living a life of repentance! 1 John 4:8
8. guard the gates of their eyes, ears and heart. Proverbs 4:20-27
9. are aware of the many voices, false prophets, and messengers in the world; and test the spirit to see if what is said aligns with God's word. 1 Thessalonians 5:21

Pray that Evangelists...

1. pray and thank the Lord for counting them worthy of the call to be an Evangelist. 1 Timothy 1:12 p
2. ask the Lord to fill them with zeal for His work. Isaiah 37:32
3. pray and ask the Lord to give them wisdom and strategy for evangelism. Proverbs 4:7
4. pray and ask the Holy Spirit to show the way and lead the way in evangelism and soul winning. Acts 13:4
5. pray and ask the Lord to lead them to lands and places where the need is greatest and the harvest is truly ripe. Psalm 107:7
6. pray and ask the Lord to deliver them and other evangelists from unreasonable wicked people in the quest for souls. 2 Thessalonians 3:2-3
7. pray and ask the Lord to give them appropriate supplies for effective and productive evangelism. Isaiah 48:21
8. pray and ask the Lord to give them real souls, to turn the heart of many after Him, both great and small so they may come to the knowledge of the truth and receive eternal life. Acts 13:48-49

Pray that Pastors...

1. ensure their rod and staff are used for Godly purposes. Psalm 23:4
2. pray that pastures and streams are spiritually nourishing. Psalm 23:2
3. are truly called to be a shepherd. John 10:1-5
4. lead with compassion, by example, and in truth. Colossians 3:12
5. demonstrate boldness. Ephesians 6:19
6. are sanctified in the truth. John 17:17
7. open door for the gospel. Colossians 4:2-4
8. speak sound doctrine. Titus 2:1
9. have pure hearts. Titus 1:15
10. shepherd the flocks of God. Acts 20:28

11. have servants' hearts. Matthew 20:25-28

12. have hearts for the church in spite of personal trials. 2 Corinthians 11:28

Pray that teachers...

1. have the mind of Christ. 1 Corinthians 2:16

2. have the knowledge of God and His Word. Colossians 1:10

3. have the boldness required to teach and speak God's word in spirit and truth. 1 Thessalonians 2:2

4. have love for people and a desire for them to know God. 2 Peter 3:18

5. have the willingness to seek and impart God's word. 1 Chronicles 22:19 and 1 Corinthians 2:13

6. are teachable, even as they teach. Mark 4:25

7. surrender every subject matter and lesson plan to the Lord. Philippians 4:7

8. always let the Holy Spirit guide them. Galatians 5:25

9. know the audience and subject matter that they teach. Galatians 6:6

Forgiveness, Healing, and Peace (Matthew 3:2, Matthew 4:17) Forgiveness is not optional, it is a requirement for those who desire true fellowship and peace with God! Today it's time to ask the Father to walk you through the hurt, pain, betrayal, and sins that left you weighted down.

Prayer: Father, in the name of Jesus, I cast off all the weight I've carried for years that set me back from being in a true relationship with you. Deliver me Father from all my sins, past, present, and future, so I can be the son/daughter you called me to be. Father, I repent NOW, in the name of Jesus, and I thank you for receiving me NOW in the name of Jesus!

Repentance is our Action and Forgiveness is God's Reaction to us! (Psalm 51:10) Repentance is the perfect response, demonstrating our need for a Savior. God sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to die on a cross for our sins. We can say we Love the Lord with our mouth but if our actions do NOT line up with our words, they are ONLY words. Today reflect on how you respond to what Jesus is requiring of you. Take a look at your actions not the actions of others. True change always starts with accepting the truth about oneself.

Prayer: Father, help me look at my ways. Search my heart Lord, and renew a right spirit in me. Father, I need to know the truth and need to stop believing the lies of the enemy. I trust you today Lord, and desire to turn from my sins once and for all! In Jesus' name, Amen
